<p>Dallas boasts a strong record of 4-0 before bye weeks and 4-1 in their last five Monday games. Additionally, they have a 10-3 record in the second of back-to-back road games. In their series against the LA Chargers, Dallas has been dominant recently with a 3-1 record in their last four matchups. The Chargers, on the other hand, have an impressive 5-1 record in their fifth game of the season, 4-0 after playing Las Vegas, and a 3-1 record on Mondays over the past three years.</p> <p>Since 2009, NFL underdogs coming off a Thursday loss by 14 points or more have proven to be a good bet, recording a 27-15-1 ATS. The Cowboys have also shown resilience with an 8-2-0 ATS record when playing away and coming off a single loss over the past seven years. <p>The Bills haven't fared well when favored by over 9 points, recording a 0-4 mark. Conversely, since 1996, the Giants have an impressive 11-3 ATS record on the road, particularly after enduring a three-game losing streak. Historically, NFL teams boasting a winning percentage of .600 or higher, who are coming back from London and have just suffered both a straight-up and against-the-spread loss, are 0-5 SU & ATS standing. However, there's an optimistic pattern: NFL squads returning from London games, in which they scored 30 or fewer points, have a promising 14-7-1 SU and 15-5-2 ATS history. Additionally, this season's data indicates that all teams favored by 10 or more points have a 4-1 record ATS.
